

## Square-shaped Select Pillow

### You need

- Pfaff sewing machine
- 25" x 25" (63x63 cm) of terry fabric or terry towel
- 34" x 25" (86 x 63cm) of turquoise linen fabric
- Sewing thread to match the terry fabric
- Pins
- Pillow form or batting



### Pfaff Accessories

### Cut

5/8" (1,5 cm) seam allowance included in all measurements.

From terry fabric, 1 pillow front piece 25" x 25" (63 x 63 cm)

From linen fabric, 2 pillow back pieces 17" x 25" (43 x 63 cm)

### Sew

- Fold and press to the wrong side 3/8" (1cm) on one long side of both back pillow pieces. Illustration 1
- Fold and press to the wrong side another 3/4" (2cm) creating a hem Illustration 2
- Top stitch close to the inner fold. For a perfect narrow topstitch snap on the Narrow Edge foot (820217-096) and adjust the needle position to fit your project.
- Place the pillow front piece on a table with the right side up
- Place a pillow back piece on top of the front piece right sides together as illustrated. Illustration 3. Pin in place.
- Place the other pillow back piece on top of the front piece and first pillow back piece overlapping centre section. Pin in place. Illustration 4
- Sew around all four sides. Trim the corners and turn right side out through the opening on the back.
